WE KNOW IS THAT:

- **1 in 4 women** and **1 in 7 men** will experience domestic violence in their lifetime.
- An average of **24 people per minute** are victims of rape, physical violence or stalking by an intimate partner in the United States.
- The presence of a gun in domestic violence situations increases the risk of **homicide for women by 500%**.
